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Application Requirements

- 1. Those who have completed 12 years or more of school education under their education system. (11 years in Myanmar and Uzbekistan)
- 2. The application must be made within 4 years (in principle) after graduating from the final educational background.
 - X In principle, 27 years old or younger.
- 3. Those who sound in both mind and body, and comply with Japanese laws, rules, and regulations of the school.
- 4. Those who are expected to be allowed to enter Japan by due process.
- 5. Those who have a financial supporter who can pay the expenses necessary for studying in Japan.
- 6. Those who completed more than 150 hours of studying Japanese at their Japanese language institutions or those who have Japanese Language Proficiency Test N5 or higher. (Including those who have the same level of N5 or higher in other Japanese Language Proficiency Tests.)
- 7. (Vietnam) High school third-year average score is 6.5 or higher.
- 8. (Nepal) Graduated from high school in 2 years and the grade is with CGPA/GPA2.5 or higher.
- 9. (Sri Lanka) Passed O Level and completed Grade 12 or more

Procedure Flow

- 1. Submit a interview form to us through a study abroad agency 《Close of application on Friday, May 10.》
- 2. Screening process, examination and online interview
 - * Announcement of the result within 3 days after the examination.
- 3. Screening application documents
- 4. Sending the scan data

《Close of accepting scan data on Friday, May 17.》

5. Sending the original documents with Japanese translation.

《Deadline: Friday, May 24》

- 6. Bulk application to the Immigration Bureau (Friday, June 7)
 - *Submission of additional documents (Monday, June 17)

Attention: All examinees will apply in one batch (June 7) to the Immigration Bureau.

New applicants cannot be accepted on the additional submission date (June 17).

- Submitted documents will not be returned in principle, but original documents that cannot be reissued will be returned after the Immigration Bureau's examination has been completed.

Details of Required Documents (No.1~No.21 on page 3)

1. ID Card or Passport or Birth Certificate

Submit the applicant's passport, identity card, or birth certificate

2. Application for Admission (6-1)

- Write the name of Province or Prefecture in the "Place of Birth" column.
- Make sure to write your temporary address in the "Temporary" column.

3. Educational Background (6-2)

- For Educational background, write the school name and address, month and year of entry and graduation in chronological order. Write the expected month and year of graduation when the applicant is still enrolled in college/University.
 - In this case, write "Expected" followed by the month and year. e.g.2019/10-2023/11 (Expected)
- In the case that the applicant entered an elementary school at any irregular age, a verification document from the school is required.
- If there is any blank period in the educational background (including basic 12 years education), an explanation document is required.

4. Purpose of Studying Japanese (6-3)

- This document should concisely and clearly explain the reason and purpose for studying Japanese. Mentioned plans after completing the language course.
- Be sure to write and sign by applicants.

5. Graduation Certificate or Enrollment Certificate for college or University

At the time of application, if you are currently enrolled in a university or college, the enrollment certificate is required.

6. Academic Transcript of University or college

8. High School Academic Transcript

9. Certificate of Japanese Study History (6-4)

- Certificate of Japanese study history issued by the institution where the applicant learned Japanese, describing the period of study, study hours per day, study days per week, and hours already studied.
- School seal and signature by the person in charge of the Institute are required.


10. Japanese Language Proficiency Certificate

Certificate and Transcript are required.

13. ID Photos (4cm × 3cm) 6 pieces



Photos taken within 3 months before the application date, without wearing a hat, from the chest to the upper head. The applicant's Nationality, Name and Date of birth must be written on the back of the photos.

14. Cost Payment Written Oath (6-5)

- Describe necessary items such as the relationship between the applicant and the financial supporter, reasons for consenting to a financial support, the timing and method of remittance of school fees and living expenses. Be sure to sign by the financial supporter.
- If there are two or more sponsors, be sure to sign by both people in the same document.

 (Applicant's parents or a member of the family in the second degree, living in the same household are encouraged to be a sponsor. If not, need to be discussed.)

15. Family Relationship Certificate

The document must prove the relationship between the applicant and the sponsor.

16. Bank Balance Certificate

The Bank balance certificate issued at the time of application must be submitted. The certificate must be issued by the bank which deals with foreign currencies.

17. Bank Statement for the past 3 years or more

18. Statement of Asset Formation Process for the past 3 years

*Only who is unable to submit the bank statement for the past 1 year or more

In general, it has to be created by the accountant

19. Employment Certificate

The sponsor is employed by any organization at the time of application, a certificate issued by the organization is required.

20. Income Certificate

- © Certificate of all income for the past 3 years to be issued by a public institution or organization from Which a financial supporter gains his/her income.
- If there are two or more income sources, submit all the certificates.

Payment of School Fees

- 1. Payment of the initial fee must be made by the designated date when the Certificate of Eligibility is issued.
- 2. The payment must be made by bank transfer. The remittance fee will be borne by the financial supporter.
- 3. After confirming the payment was made, the Certificate of Eligibility will be sent to the applicant (or an agent/school).
- 4. Basically, once the payment has been made, the fee of the entrance examination, admission dormitory, and school payment will **not be refunded**.

However, in the following cases, we will apply our rules.

- ★ In case of (a) VISA is denied (b) Declining admission for personal reasons after receiving "Certificate of Eligibility," we will deduct Application fee (¥30,000), Enrollment fee (¥70,000), Entering dormitory fee (¥36,000), and Remittance fee from the initial payment and refund the rest to the financial supporter.
